All children and young people who attend GPSO have a right to feel and be safe. GPSO provide a child safe culture by supporting children and young people, their parents, guardians, families and communities. We are committed to providing a child-safe and child-friendly environment, where children and young people are safe and feel safe and are able to actively participate in decisions that affect their lives.

### Our commitment to children and young people

#### We intend to:

- Provide a safe and supportive environment
- Ensure that the experience of children and young people are free from any form of harmful conduct
- Empower children and young people so they feel able to respond to unacceptable behaviour
- Ensure children and young people know who to approach If they feel unsafe or have any child safety concerns

### Our commitment to parents, carers, families and their communities

#### We intend to:

- Ensure the parents of a child have ultimate decision making about the child and the services the child receives
- Share information with adults about keeping children and young people safe, including how to make a report if they suspect a child is being harmed

## Our commitment to being a child safe organisation

#### We intent to:

- Ensure our staff follow our code of conduct
- Use child safe recruitment processes that include a Working With Children Check (WWC) and other screening checks as appropriate
- Induct our staff so they recognise their role in keeping children and young people safe, and ensure there are ongoing learning and development opportunities related to child safety
- Ensure that staff know how and when to report any concerns, complaints or allegations of concerning conduct.
